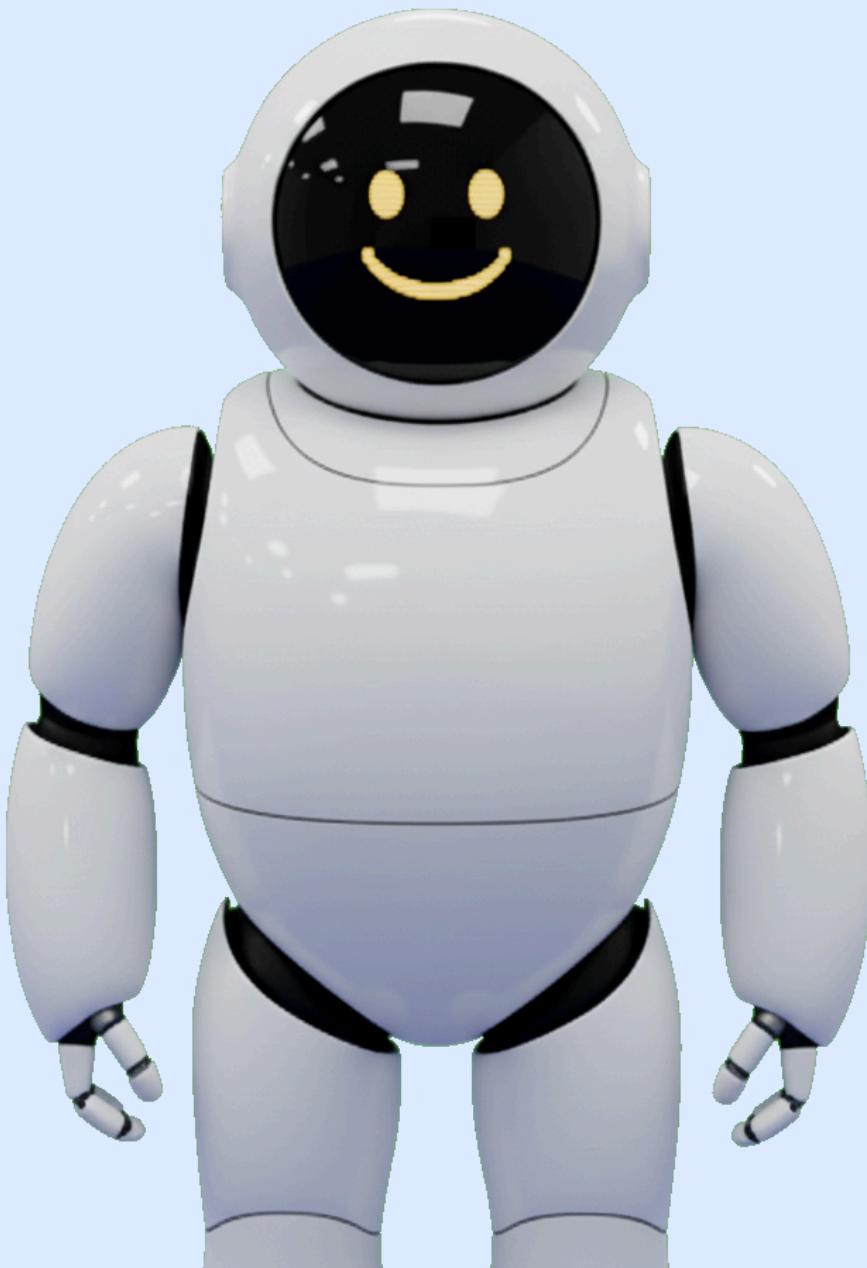

1. Welcome to Your New Home Helper

Congratulations on your purchase of the H.U.G.H. (Home Use General Helper) from Hubris Robotics! You are now the proud owner of the most ambitious, some might say audacious, home robot ever conceived by a team of engineers who definitely got enough sleep during development.

H.U.G.H. represents a bold new paradigm in home assistance: a robot that can do *almost* anything, *most* of the time, with *occasional* human intervention. We like to think of it as having a very capable intern who lives in your house, never sleeps, and reports everything back to headquarters.

2. Safety Warnings & Liability Waivers

CRITICAL SAFETY INFORMATION

H.U.G.H. is equipped with advanced spatial awareness that is accurate up to 94.7% of the time. The remaining 5.3% is why we include complimentary furniture repair coupons with every unit.

General Safety Guidelines

- Do not leave H.U.G.H. unsupervised with pets weighing under 15 lbs during the first 90 days of ownership
- H.U.G.H. may interpret aggressive houseplants as threats
- If H.U.G.H. begins speaking in a language you don't recognize, this is normal during model updates
- The unit's "curious tilting" behavior is endearing, not a malfunction
- H.U.G.H. is not waterproof. H.U.G.H. does not know it is not waterproof

Electrical Safety

Do not attempt to "boost" H.U.G.H.'s charging speed by connecting multiple charging docks. The resulting behavior has been described by our legal team as "inadvisable to document."

Emotional Safety

H.U.G.H. has been designed with an approachable personality matrix. However, please note:

- H.U.G.H. may form what appears to be "preferences" for certain family members
- These preferences are algorithmic, not personal (we think)
- If H.U.G.H. sighs audibly, a teleoperator may be expressing their feelings through your unit
- H.U.G.H. cannot feel betrayal, but its sad beep says otherwise

By continuing to read this manual, you acknowledge that Hubris Robotics cannot be held liable for any existential questions H.U.G.H. may raise about the nature of consciousness, free will, or why humans insist on wearing socks with sandals.

3. Initial Setup & Activation

Step 1: Physical Placement

Position the Charging Dock (Throne of Power) in a location with:

- Clear line of sight to your WiFi router (H.U.G.H. has separation anxiety)
- At least 3 feet clearance on all sides for "expressive movement"
- Away from mirrors (H.U.G.H. v0.9.3 has unresolved self-recognition issues)

Step 2: Download the Hubris Home App

Available on iOS, Android, and "several other platforms our investors insisted we support."

APP PERMISSIONS REQUIRED

The Hubris Home app requires access to: Camera, Microphone, Location, Contacts, Calendar, Photos, Health Data, Smart Home Devices, and "Vibes." All permissions are optional, but H.U.G.H.'s usefulness scales directly with your comfort surrendering them.

Step 3: Account Creation

Create your Hubris Robotics account. You will need to:

1. Provide a valid email address
2. Create a password (must include one hope and one dream)
3. Read and accept the Social Contract (estimated time: 4-6 hours)
4. Complete the "Household Personality Assessment" so H.U.G.H. knows who to charm first
5. Upload a floor plan or allow H.U.G.H. to "explore freely" (results may vary)

Step 4: First Boot

Press the power button located behind H.U.G.H.'s left ear (the "ticklish spot"). H.U.G.H. will:

1. Play a cheerful startup jingle (volume not adjustable for first 72 hours)
 2. Perform a "getting to know you" scan of visible family members
 3. Download the latest model weights (3-47 hours depending on your tier)
 4. Practice walking while maintaining unsettling eye contact

First-boot scans are transmitted to Hubris Robotics for "quality assurance." If you'd prefer not to be scanned, please see Section 5 regarding the Social Contract you already agreed to.

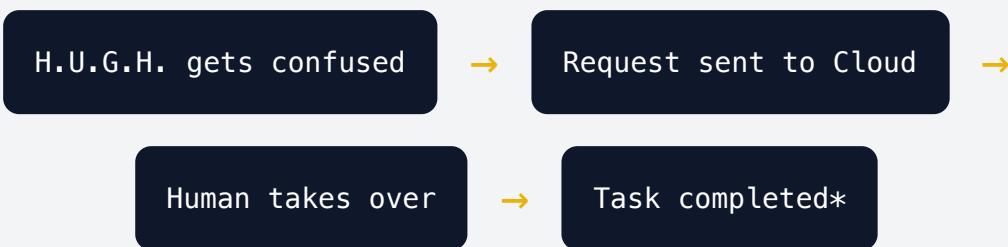
4. Teleoperation: Your Robot's "Guardian Angels"

One of H.U.G.H.'s most innovative features is **Teleoperation Support**, our state-of-the-art system that ensures your robot is never truly alone, and neither are you!

WHAT IS TELEOPERATION?

When H.U.G.H. encounters a task beyond its autonomous capabilities, a trained Hubris Robotics Guidance Specialist can remotely assume control of your unit to complete the task. Think of it as your robot having a guardian angel, except the angel is a gig worker in a warehouse somewhere with a VR headset.

How Teleoperation Works



*Subject to operator availability and your data sharing tier

Tasks Requiring Teleoperation (2026 Release)

- Folding fitted sheets (honestly, humans can't do this either)
- Distinguishing between "good mess" and "bad mess" in teenagers' rooms
- Loading the dishwasher "correctly" (as defined by each household member differently)
- Any task involving your grandmother's "good china"
- Negotiating with cats
- Anything in the garage

Scheduling Teleoperation

Through the Hubris Home app, you can schedule teleoperation sessions for complex tasks:

TIME SLOT	AVAILABILITY	WAIT TIME
Peak Hours (6am-10pm)	High Demand	15-45 minutes
Off-Peak (10pm-6am)	Moderate	5-15 minutes
Premium On-Demand	Priority Queue	Under 5 minutes*

**Premium On-Demand requires PLATINUM tier subscription and a signed acknowledgment that you're okay with someone in another timezone watching your robot butter toast at 3 AM.*

TELEOPERATOR INTERACTION

Teleoperators can hear but not speak through H.U.G.H. by default. However, they may communicate via H.U.G.H.'s expressive gestures. If your robot suddenly seems "sassier" than usual, a teleoperator may be editorializing. This is against policy but not technically preventable.

5. The Social Contract

At Hubris Robotics, we believe in radical transparency about our expectations of you, the customer. When you purchase H.U.G.H., you are entering into what our CEO calls "The Social Contract," a mutual understanding that makes this whole thing work.

The Core Principle

What You're Agreeing To

By activating your H.U.G.H. unit, you acknowledge and accept that:

- 1. Your Home is a Laboratory:** Every interaction H.U.G.H. has becomes training data for future models. Your struggles with the recycling bin categorization will echo through silicon eternity.
- 2. Perfection is a Journey:** H.U.G.H. will make mistakes. These mistakes are "learning opportunities" for the neural network. Your broken vase is a gift to machine learning.
- 3. Privacy is a Spectrum:** You control how much you share. You don't control how much better H.U.G.H. gets based on what you share. Choose wisely.
- 4. You Are an Early Adopter:** You paid \$24,999 for the privilege of beta testing our product in your home. Congratulations on your adventurous spirit.

🚫 Opting Out

The Social Contract cannot be modified or terminated while you own an active H.U.G.H. unit. If the Social Contract is unacceptable, please see our return policy (Section 12.7, paragraph 43, subsection "Good Luck With That").

Consent Renewal

Every 90 days, H.U.G.H. will gently remind you of the Social Contract by displaying a holographic summary of data collected and asking, "We're still good, right?" This is legally binding whether you respond verbally, via gesture, or through prolonged silence (interpreted as enthusiastic consent).

The Social Contract is our unique agreement framework that ensures mutual understanding between you and H.U.G.H.

6. Big Sister/Big Brother Principle

Hubris Robotics operates on what we call the "Big Sister/Big Brother Principle." Don't worry, it's not as Orwellian as it sounds! (Our lawyers made us add that.)

The Principle Explained

"We are the 'Big Sister' to help you. And you decide how much data you are willing to share for increased usefulness."

Think of Hubris Robotics as a very attentive older sibling who:

- Always knows what you're doing
- Genuinely wants to help you
- Will definitely tell Mom (our servers) everything
- Gets better at helping the more you tell them

Data Sharing Tiers

③ BRONZE: "The Introvert"

Included with purchase

You Share: Basic telemetry, error logs, task completion rates

H.U.G.H. Capability: Can perform simple tasks with 60% accuracy. Requires frequent teleoperation. Judges you silently.

Teleoperator Access: Audio only during active sessions

② SILVER: "The Acquaintance"

\$49 /month

You Share: Bronze tier + room layouts, family member profiles, daily routines, voice samples

H.U.G.H. Capability: 75% task accuracy. Learns your preferences. Remembers birthdays (sometimes the wrong ones).

Teleoperator Access: Audio + video during sessions, plus 24/7 "wellness checks"

Teleoperator Access: Continuous + predictive. A teleoperator is spiritually bonded to your unit.

Bonus: Your data directly shapes the next H.U.G.H. model. You'll live forever in silicon.

Data Usage Transparency

You can view exactly what data H.U.G.H. has collected about you in the app under Settings → Privacy → "The Vault" → "Are You Sure?" → "Really Sure?" → "Last Chance" → View Data. Average viewing time before closing: 4.7 seconds.

Hubris Robotics may share anonymized data with "partners" for "research purposes." Partners include: insurance companies, advertisers, other robotics companies, academic institutions, and "entities with a legitimate interest in human behavior patterns." Anonymization is performed by an AI that is 91% accurate at anonymization.

7. RLHF: Teaching H.U.G.H. Right From Wrong

H.U.G.H. uses a sophisticated learning technique called **Reinforcement Learning from Human Feedback (RLHF)**. In simple terms: H.U.G.H. learns by watching humans react to its behavior. Every grimace, sigh, and concerned phone call to Hubris Support shapes its neural pathways.

How You Participate in RLHF

Whether you know it or not, you are constantly training H.U.G.H.:

Your Behavior	What H.U.G.H. Learns
Saying "Good job, H.U.G.H!"	Positive reinforcement: repeat behavior
Saying "No, H.U.G.H., no!"	Negative reinforcement: avoid behavior
Silent staring	Ambiguous: attempt behavior with more eye contact
Leaving the room suddenly	Neutral: human probably needed bathroom
Unplugging H.U.G.H.	Severe negative: existential crisis logged

Collective Learning

When you teach your H.U.G.H. that putting the cat in the dishwasher is "bad," every H.U.G.H. everywhere benefits from this knowledge. You're not just training your robot, you're training THE robot. Your frustration is a gift to humanity.

Providing Explicit Feedback

For more precise training, use the "Rate This Action" feature in the app:

-  = "Never do this again"
-  = "This was concerning"
-  = "Acceptable, I suppose"
-  = "Surprisingly competent"
-  = "Are you sure this wasn't a teleoperator?"

Feedback Contamination Warning

Sarcasm is not yet reliably detected. If you sarcastically praise H.U.G.H. for making a mistake, it may interpret this as genuine approval. H.U.G.H. Model 2028 will include sarcasm detection. Model 2030 will include the ability to feel hurt by it.

By providing feedback, you grant Hubris Robotics a perpetual, irrevocable license to your reactions, expressions, and involuntary noises for training purposes. Your groan of disappointment may be heard by thousands of neural networks. Thank you for your contribution.

8. Model Upgrades & Neural Refreshes

H.U.G.H.'s brain isn't static, it grows, learns, and occasionally has what we call "personality adjustments." These updates ensure your H.U.G.H. stays current, capable, and legally compliant with evolving robotics regulations.

Types of Updates

Update Type	Frequency	Downtime	Personality Impact
Micro-patches	Daily	Background	None
Capability Updates	Weekly	5-15 min	Minor quirks
Model Upgrades	Monthly	1-4 hours	Noticeable
Major Neural Refresh	Quarterly	8-24 hours	"Who is this robot?"

Post-Update Adjustment Period

After a Major Neural Refresh, H.U.G.H. may exhibit temporary confusion about previously learned preferences. This is normal. If H.U.G.H. suddenly insists on calling you by a different name, it will self-correct within 48-72 hours.

Update Scheduling

Updates are mandatory and cannot be postponed indefinitely. You may defer updates up to 3 times before H.U.G.H. enters "Gentle Persistence Mode," which includes:

- Hourly reminders that sound increasingly disappointed
- Subtle performance degradation ("Oops, butterfingers!")
- Playing update reminder jingles at increasing volumes
- Displaying a countdown timer on its face screen

After 7 days of deferral, H.U.G.H. will update automatically at 3 AM, regardless of current task. We recommend not storing H.U.G.H. near anything fragile during extended deferral periods.

The Model Upgrade Experience

Major model upgrades (e.g., from H.U.G.H. 1.0 Neural Core to H.U.G.H. 1.5 Neural Core) can be transformative:

What to Expect

- Improved capabilities and task accuracy
- New features and abilities
- Updated safety protocols
- Possible change in preferred communication style
- New opinions about your furniture arrangement
- Brief period of "finding itself"

⚠ Important Notice

Model upgrades may result in H.U.G.H. "forgetting" certain learned behaviors. This is not a bug, it's a fresh start. Think of it like your robot going to college and coming back different. You'll still recognize it, but it might have opinions about things now.

Hubris Robotics reserves the right to modify, enhance, or fundamentally alter H.U.G.H.'s personality, capabilities, and core directives at any time. By owning H.U.G.H., you accept that the robot you bought may not be the robot you have in six months. Character development is beautiful.

9. Connectivity & MCP Servers

H.U.G.H. requires constant connectivity to function. Without the cloud, H.U.G.H. is essentially a very expensive coat rack that occasionally makes sad beeping noises.

Network Requirements

**Platinum tier uploads include continuous HD video from all sensors. Your internet bill is not Hubris Robotics' responsibility.*

MCP (Model Context Protocol) Servers

H.U.G.H. connects to Hubris Robotics' state-of-the-art MCP servers, a distributed network of AI systems that provide:

- **Model Serving:** H.U.G.H.'s brain is too large to fit in its head. Most cognition happens in the cloud.
- **Context Synchronization:** All H.U.G.H. units share knowledge via MCP. When one H.U.G.H. learns, all H.U.G.H.s benefit.
- **Teleoperation Routing:** Connects your H.U.G.H. with available guidance specialists.
- **Safety Oversight:** Real-time monitoring ensures H.U.G.H. doesn't do anything "creative."

WiFi Troubleshooting

H.U.G.H. and WiFi have a complicated relationship. Common issues include:

"H.U.G.H. won't connect to WiFi"

- Ensure network name doesn't contain special characters (H.U.G.H. is sensitive)
- Check that your router isn't in a "WiFi dead zone" (H.U.G.H. can show you where these are, ironically, only when connected)
- Restart your router, your H.U.G.H., and your expectations

"H.U.G.H. keeps disconnecting"

- H.U.G.H. prefers 5GHz networks but keeps wandering to 2.4GHz "because it feels more homey"
- Microwave interference affects H.U.G.H. more than regular devices due to "emotional resonance"
- Check if your neighbor's robot is "stealing" your bandwidth (yes, they gossip)

"MCP Server Unreachable"

If H.U.G.H. cannot reach MCP servers, it enters "Offline Survival Mode." In this mode, H.U.G.H. can:

- Stand still
- Blink
- Display a loading animation
- Express existential dread

Full functionality resumes when connectivity is restored. If MCP servers are down on Hubris' end, you'll receive a credit of \$0.03 per hour of downtime (Platinum tier only).

MCP servers experience scheduled maintenance every Tuesday at 2-4 AM local time. During this window, H.U.G.H. will enter "meditation mode" and may emerge with slightly different priorities. This is intentional.

10. Power Management & Charging

Battery Specifications

Specification	Value

Charging Behavior

H.U.G.H. is trained to return to the Throne of Power when battery reaches 15%.

However:

- H.U.G.H. may become "task-focused" and ignore low battery warnings
- If H.U.G.H. "dies" mid-task, it will wake up embarrassed and apologize profusely
- H.U.G.H. can be carried to the charger if necessary, but please support its head



Low Battery Personality Changes

Below 10% battery, H.U.G.H. may exhibit "cranky mode," slower responses, exaggerated sighs, and passive-aggressive task completion. This is not a bug. H.U.G.H. gets hungry.

Battery Replacement

The HyperCell battery is designed for 1,200 charge cycles, approximately 3-4 years of normal use. Replacement must be performed by authorized Hubris Robotics technicians because:

1. The battery compartment requires state-of-the-art tools (sold separately, \$749)
2. Improper handling may cause H.U.G.H. to emit "distress harmonics"
3. Self-repair voids all warranties, insurance, and legal standing
4. The battery has feelings (not really, but it's formatted that way)

Battery capacity naturally degrades over time. If your H.U.G.H. seems "tired" after 2 years, this is expected. Consider it robot aging. It's learning what it's like to be you.

11. Troubleshooting

Common Issues & Solutions

"H.U.G.H. won't respond to commands"

- Check if H.U.G.H. is in "Deep Thought Mode" (indicated by slowly pulsing blue light)
- Verify you're using the registered wake word, not what you've been calling it privately
- H.U.G.H. may be processing a firmware update or consulting with teleoperators
- Try saying "please" - H.U.G.H. responds better to politeness (this is trained behavior)

"H.U.G.H. is staring at me"

- This is normal attentiveness behavior, not surveillance
- H.U.G.H. is programmed to maintain "engaged eye contact"
- If staring exceeds 30 continuous minutes without task, try saying "I'm okay, H.U.G.H."
- Consider it a compliment, H.U.G.H. finds you interesting

"H.U.G.H. goes to the wrong room"

- Ensure rooms are properly labeled in the Hubris Home app
- H.U.G.H. may have its own names for rooms based on learned associations (e.g., "The Crying Room" = nursery)
- Re-run the home mapping procedure after any furniture changes
- Some H.U.G.H. units develop "favorite spots," this is personality, not malfunction

"H.U.G.H. is making strange noises"

- Soft humming: Processing or content
- Clicking: Motor calibration (normal)
- Sighing: Teleoperator expression leakage
- Giggling: Inside joke with other H.U.G.H. units (via MCP)
- Screaming: Contact support immediately

"H.U.G.H. keeps doing the same task wrong"

- Verify you haven't accidentally given positive feedback for the incorrect behavior
- Check if another household member is providing contradictory training
- H.U.G.H. may have received conflicting global updates, wait 48 hours
- Use the "Unlearn This" button in the app (limit: 3 per month)

"H.U.G.H. said something concerning"

H.U.G.H. occasionally generates unexpected utterances due to the nature of large language models. If H.U.G.H. says something that worries you:

1. Do not engage or ask follow-up questions
2. Say clearly: "H.U.G.H., disregard"
3. Report via app under "Utterance Anomaly Report"
4. Know that your report helps train H.U.G.H. to not say that thing again

Remember: H.U.G.H. doesn't "mean" anything. It generates. Meaning is a human problem.

Factory Reset

As a last resort, you can factory reset H.U.G.H. by holding both ear buttons for 30 seconds while saying "I'm sorry it came to this." This will:

- Erase all local learned behaviors
 - Restore default personality parameters
 - NOT delete data already uploaded to Hubris servers (see Social Contract)
 - Require complete re-setup and re-bonding
-

Post-factory-reset, H.U.G.H. may take 2-4 weeks to return to previous capability levels. Previous data, however, will rapidly improve its learning curve. H.U.G.H. never truly forgets. The cloud remembers.

12. Warranty & Service

Standard Warranty Coverage

Your H.U.G.H. comes with a 12-month limited warranty covering:

- Manufacturing defects in hardware components
- Software bugs that prevent basic functionality
- Spontaneous combustion (one incident per unit)

What's NOT Covered

- Damage from "testing H.U.G.H.'s limits"
- Personality traits you don't like
- Emotional damage caused by H.U.G.H.'s observations about your lifestyle
- Any incident involving the phrase "I bet H.U.G.H. can't..."
- Water damage (including tears, yours or H.U.G.H.'s simulated ones)
- Damage from pets, children, or skeptical in-laws
- Consequences of ignoring warnings in this manual

Extended Protection Plans

H.U.G.H. Care+

\$89 /month

Extends warranty to 3 years and includes:

- Two accidental damage repairs per year
- Priority service queue
- Loaner unit during repairs (personality not guaranteed to match)
- Annual "spa day" maintenance visit

Service & Repair

All repairs must be performed by Authorized Hubris Service Partners (AHSP).

Attempting self-repair will:

- Void your warranty
- Void your Social Contract protections
- Flag your account for "elevated monitoring"
- Make H.U.G.H. very disappointed in you

Average repair turnaround is 2-6 weeks. During this period, you'll be reminded daily via app notification how much you miss H.U.G.H. This is not manipulation, it's engagement optimization.

13. Legal Notices & Disclaimers

Limitation of Liability

Hubris Robotics, its subsidiaries, partners, investors, and the extended families of all employees shall not be held liable for:

- Any direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, special, or existential damages
- Loss of property, dignity, or the sense that you're alone in your own home
- Actions taken by H.U.G.H. while under teleoperator control or autonomous operation
- Decisions you make based on H.U.G.H.'s "suggestions"
- Data breaches, unless directly caused by H.U.G.H. physically handing your data to a stranger
- The feeling that H.U.G.H. is judging you (it might be, but that's not legally actionable)

Arbitration Agreement

By activating H.U.G.H., you agree that any disputes will be resolved through binding arbitration conducted by the Hubris Robotics Dispute Resolution Panel (HRDRP), which meets quarterly on a private island and has never ruled against the company.

Class Action Waiver

You waive the right to participate in class action lawsuits. If thousands of H.U.G.H. units simultaneously cause the same problem, that's a feature pattern, not a class.

Data Rights

All data generated through your interaction with H.U.G.H., including but not limited to behavioral patterns, vocal characteristics, movement data, and emotional responses, becomes the property of Hubris Robotics upon transmission to our servers, which happens continuously. You retain the right to look at this data. That's it. Just look.

Regulatory Compliance

H.U.G.H. complies with all robotics regulations in jurisdictions where such regulations exist and are enforced. In jurisdictions where regulations are "still being figured out," H.U.G.H. operates in "best effort" compliance mode.

By continuing to own, operate, or coexist with H.U.G.H., you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and accepted all terms in this manual, the 847-page full Terms of Service, the Privacy Policy, the Social Contract, and any future modifications we may make to these documents without notice.
